

Activities

The children enjoy many fun activities throughout the year.

1. Truth Tracker Games (weekly)

Every week Faith Force, Scripture Spies, and Tiny Trackers play exciting group games. Faith Force and Scripture Spies have relay games as well as large group games. Tiny Trackers play simple, energetic games as a group.

2. Friend Nights (special gospel nights)

A couple of Wednesday nights a year are set aside for children to invite their friends and neighbors. In the weeks preceding the Friend Night, the children pray for their friends and write invitations to them. The friends are invited to come to Truth Trackers where they enjoy a fun night of games and hear a gospel message.

3. Blast Activities (Friday night activities)

Three or four times a year, the Scripture Spies and Faith Force take a Friday night to enjoy an evening of exciting activities. Whether it be playing a mystery game with their parents or enjoying a fair, the children have a BLAST at these activities!

What is Truth Trackers?

Truth Trackers is a Wednesday night program that seeks to purposefully and systematically disciple children to know the fundamental truths of the scriptures. We believe children can and need to learn the basics of the Christian faith. We accomplish this with weekly memory verses, Bible-based lessons, personal devotions, and fun activities. In Truth Trackers, children enjoy learning and applying Biblical truth!



Truth Trackers' Goals

1. To systematically and purposefully disciple children
2. To give opportunities for children to evangelize the lost
3. To incorporate the family into activities and scripture memory

The Three Divisions

Scripture Spies (1st-3rd grade) and Faith Force (4th-6th grade) are the divisions of Truth Trackers in which children experience the excitement of learning the fundamental truths of the Bible. Scripture Spies cover eighteen doctrines (below) every three years through scripture memory, devotions, and Bible lessons. When those children advance to Faith Force, they learn those same doctrines again through review, additional verses, devotions, and Bible lessons. Each

Wednesday night, Truth Trackers targets a certain topic within a doctrine and teaches that truth to the children. All the verses, devotions, and lessons are focused to disciple the children in that week's topic.



Tiny Trackers (3-to 5-year-olds) is the division of Truth Trackers in which children learn simple truths through verse memory, Bible lessons, and puppet shows. Tiny Trackers teaches these simple truths by picking out a special word found in their memory verse and teaching the children what that word means.



For instance, one week the children will memorize part of Ephesians 6:1, and the word the children will learn about that week is "obey." The children will hear a Bible lesson that teaches what "obey" means, and they will listen to a puppet show that will illustrate how they can "obey."



Awards

Children receive awards for diligently memorizing God's Word and doing their devotions. The children display their awards on their tote bags (Scripture Spies) and Bible covers (Faith Force). These awards are presented throughout the year. Children can also receive special awards at the end of the year.
