ICEBREAKERS

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS *(Answer Thoughtfully with Scripture):*

1. The best practice for understanding a parable is to read Jesus' explanation of the parable. How/where do you find Jesus' explanation of his parables? What should you do if Jesus didn't directly explain his parable? Share your thoughts with the group.
2. Jesus' teaching reflects that He was a student of OT Scripture. What are some things that help you remember passages of Scripture? Have there been any game-changing experiences in your Bible Memory or your ability to search your Bible? Share your thoughts with your group.
3. While Scripture can be understood by all Christians, what are tools or practices you use to help understand Scripture better? Are there any people, resources or practices that you regularly turn to, perhaps even to prepare for community group?
4. Jesus' disciples discussed his messages with him, and we assume one another. Do you regularly discuss the teaching that you hear with others? Have you found this practice helpful, and if so, what made it helpful?
