ICEBREAKERS

Have you ever missed an important sign or some other obvious thing you should have noticed? What happened as a result?

Have you ever tried to convince a family member or friend of something but they did not believe you? What happened, and did you ever change their mind?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS (*Answer Thoughtfully with Scripture*):

1. Why is the resurrection the most powerful sign Jesus could give? Why do you suppose this was still not enough for most of the religious leaders? What keeps people from believing in Jesus today?
2. Have you ever experienced overwhelming conviction and repentance? Have you ever seen that in others? How did their lives change? How did their testimony affect others?
3. Who are your favorite characters of the Old Testament? Jesus commends the Queen of Sheba and even the Assyrians! What other unusual/obscure figures in the Old Testament model a correct response to God and His Word?
4. What is the biggest sacrifice you have seen someone make to access biblical truth? Why would they make such an effort? What was the result? How could you seek the Wisdom of God better on a daily basis?

DIGGING DEEPER

Read Jonah 2. This is often called the Psalm of Jonah. What do you notice about this song? What lessons has Jonah learned? Do you think he took these truths to heart, based on the rest of the book?
