Following Jesus 32, The Light of the World John 8-9

I. Message

a. The proclamation – 8:12

- i. John 8:12 "Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, <u>I am the light of the world</u>: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life."
 - 1. Jesus is clearly speaking here in a spiritual sense
 - 2. And His reference is in line with Messianic prophecy
 - 3. Isaiah referenced in Matthew 4:16
 - 4. Zacharias (John the Baptist's dad) in Luke 1:76-79
 - 5. Simeon in Luke 2:29-32
 - 6. The Jews clearly understand that the Messiah was going to bring spiritual light
 - a. Isaiah light that brings spiritual life
 - b. Zacharias light that brings peace to the broken relationship between God and man
 - c. Simeon a light available to all people!

b. The proof – 9:1-24

- i. What happens now in John 9 is an amazing follow-up
- ii. John 9:1-7, 24-25
- iii. Jesus brings light to a dark world
 - 1. The blind can now see physical healing
 - 2. And those in spiritual darkness can be ushered into the light
 - 3. Jesus was after the heart of this man more than his eyes John 9:35-38

c. The plan – 9:39

- i. 39 And Jesus said, For judgment I am come into this world, that they which see not might see; and that they which see might be made blind."
- ii. "I'm going to turn religion on its head"
 - 1. The spiritually blind (sinners) will be made welcome and forgiven
 - 2. The spiritually seeing (religious people) will be left confused and wandering in darkness!
 - a. Here is how the Apostle John described Jesus John 1:1-12
 - i. Jesus was about having people BELIEVE
 - ii. It was spiritual life that Jesus wanted to give
 - iii. But so many would rather walk in darkness John 12:35-46

II. Applications

- a. **<u>Receive</u>** Have you believed in the life-giving Light of Jesus or are you blind?
 - i. 2 Corinthians 4:4-6
 - ii. Do you know God through Jesus?
 - iii. That is His plan

b. **<u>Reside</u>** – Are you walking in the light, living the life-giving ways of Jesus?

- i. Ephesians 5:8-14
- ii. Colossians 1:12-13
- iii. 1 Thessalonians 5:5-8
- iv. 1 John 1:5-7
- c. <u>**Reflect**</u> Are you clearly shining the light of Jesus on others? 1 Peter 2:9
