Following Jesus Here's Your Mission Matthew 28:19-20

I. Message

a. Duplicate

- i. Be a disciple that makes Disciples
- ii. 19 Go ye therefore, and teach all nations..."
- iii. GO do this! Initiate REAL and MEANINGFUL conversations about Jesus with those that don't know Him
 - 1. Not talk about doing it
 - 2. Not pray about doing it
 - 3. Not think about doing this
 - 4. Not send or hire others to do this
 - 5. YOU: Go make disciples of all nations!
 - 6. Simplified: Go make A disciple
 - a. GO initiate Gospel opportunities and duplicate your faith!
 - b. Luke 14:23
 - c. Acts 1:8

b. Integrate

- i. Baptize (integrate them into Church life)
- ii. 19...baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost"
 - 1. Baptism is the first step of obedience for a new believer
 - 2. It identifies them with Christ
 - 3. And it is intended to fully integrate someone into church-life
 - a. It is not necessary for salvation
 - b. But all true believers will desire to be publicly associated with Christ and His people
 - c. Make Jesus Lord and follow Him with full obedience!
 - d. Acts 8:35-38
 - e. Who are you encouraging to obey Christ?

c. Educate

- i. Disciple (teach them what I have commanded)
- ii. 20 Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you..."
- iii. We don't accomplish the FULL mission until we teach them all that Christ has taught us!
 - 1. We are to teach new disciples HOW to be disciples
 - 2. Who are you discipling?
 - 3. 2 Timothy 2:2

- 4. Is "discipleship" normal for you?
 - a. This is something that ALL believers should be doing
 - b. One way or another

II. Conclusion - YOU can do the Great Commission!

- a. Power
 - i. V.19 "Go ve therefore..."
 - ii. Jesus says, "You CAN do this because of what I just said"
 - iii. What did Jesus just say?
 - iv. V.18 "And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth."
 - 1. GO with my authority
 - 2. I have it ALL!

b. Presence

- i. You not only have His power and authority
- ii. You have the promise of His presence
 - 1. "20...and, lo, I am with you alway, even unto the end of the world. Amen"
 - 2. Jesus is with you EVERYWHERE
 - 3. Even to the end of the world
 - a. Paul in Corinth Acts 18:9-10
 - b. Paul in Rome at the end of His life 2 Timothy 4:16-17
 - c. Jesus promises His presence to obedient disciple-makers

c. Propagation

- i. You and I were not there on that mountain while Jesus was speaking
- ii. But the disciples that WERE there obeyed
 - 1. They made disciples
 - 2. They built churches
 - 3. They taught the commands of Jesus
 - 4. And their disciples carried on the obedience over many generations of believers until 2024, on the cusp of 2025
 - 5. Will we let it end with us?
 - 6. Or will we continue to obey the Master?
 - 7. The Great Commission is the ultimate registing
