How to pray for your church Ephesians 1:15-19

I. Message

a. Pray for God's wisdom to teach us about Him – v.17

- i. "The spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of God"
- ii. He's asking God to give them this knowledge...<u>of God in Christ</u>
 - 1. Ironically, the knowledge of God comes from God
 - 2. And it comes of His grace, it is a gift (like faith, joy, love)
 - a. He is not obligated to us to teach us about Himself
 - i. But all good things come from Him James 1:17
 - ii. James 1:5, Same passage need wisdom? Ask
- iii. It is the knowledge **<u>of Him</u>** that we are after
 - 1. Paul is praying that they would know in their mind what they possess in Christ
 - 2. Philippians 3:10
 - a. If you are saved, you HAVE all the Jesus you can get
 - b. You just need to KNOW Him better
 - i. Colossians 2:9-10
 - ii. To see Him for Who He really is!

b. Pray for God's understanding to enlighten us in Him – v.18

- i. You need your eyes of understanding enlightened
 - 1. You have "eyes to see but you cannot see", as Jesus said
 - 2. "Ears to hear but you cannot hear"
- ii. You have the hope, the riches, the inheritance
 - 1. You just can't see it all yet
 - 2. This is why Paul is praying for them
 - 3. Notice: two things specifically
 - a. <u>Understand the hope of His calling what you have NOW</u>
 - i. Romans 8:28 to God's eternal purpose
 - ii. Romans 8:29 called to be like Jesus
 - iii. 1 Corinthians 1:9 called into fellowship
 - iv. 1 Corinthians 7:15 called to peace
 - v. Galatians 5:13 called to liberty
 - vi. 1 Thessalonians 2:12 called to glory
 - vii. 1 Thessalonians 4:7 called to holiness
 - viii. 1 Timothy 6:12 called to life
 - ix. 1 Peter 2:9 called to light
 - x. 1 Peter 3:9 called to blessing
 - xi. 1 Peter 1:3 called to virtue

- b. Understand riches of inheritance what you have COMING
 - i. Romans 8:17 "And if (since) children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ;"
 - ii. It's actually HIS (Jesus') inheritance
 - iii. But it is reserved for you!
 - iv. You are a full joint-heir
 - v. 1 Corinthians 2:9-11

c. Pray for God's power to work in us for Him - v.19-20

- i. Or to more deeply understand this power
- ii. (4 different Greek words for power in these 2 verses)
 - 1. God has exceedingly great power
 - a. Ephesians 3:20 Power that is "...exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think..."
 - b. And He has it TO US-WARD who believe! v.19
 - c. "Toward us, the faithful"
 - d. His power is on full display in the healthy church!
 - i. It was the power He wrought in Christ at the resurrection
 - ii. The ultimate demonstration of power
 - iii. That is the level of God's power is to YOU-ward!
 - 1. To evangelize Acts 1:8
 - 2. To suffer victoriously 2 Corinthians 4:7-9
 - 3. To serve Colossians 1:29
 - a. God's power pulls us to one another
 - b. For evangelism, suffering, service

- II. Conclusion
 - a. Are we daily connecting to Him in Jesus? (prayer)
 - b. And are we praying for the right things for each other?
 - c. Hebrews 4:16 "Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need."
 - d. Practical ways to pray better for FBCW:
 - i. <u>Think of spiritual concerns as the highest priority</u>
 - ii. Schedule a regular time of week to pray for our church
 - iii. <u>Pray as specifically as you can for individuals</u>
