# **Building with God's Blueprints Ephesians 2:19-22**

# I. The Citizens of His Church (v19)

## A. No Longer Foreigners and Strangers (v19a)

- o When you were a foreigner and stranger:
- o V13 you were FAR OFF

### B. Now Fellow-Citizens and Saints (v19b)

No longer **Dead** – Now **Alive** (In Christ) v1,5.

No longer separated from God – Brought Near (By Christ) v13.

No longer a Foreigner – Now Fellow-Citizen with all the Saints in the Household of God (v19)

- As a Citizen You have Rights
- As a Citizen You have Responsibilities.
- How you display your Citizenship matters.

#### II. The Construction of His Church

#### A. Built upon the Foundation (v.20a)

- Eph 4:11-14
  - o It is great that we collectively propagate the Word:
    - But God's church LIVES out the Word.
    - It is the foundation/bedrock/ground zero of all that we do but individually and corporately.
  - o Is that true in your life? Are the Scriptures the foundation of everything you do? And how you conduct yourself?

# B. Built in a Formation (there is a guide, an organization to the structure) (v.20b)

- It was the cornerstone that was used to bear the weight of the entire structure and tie the walls together.
- These were often substantial pieces and the most important!
  - The cornerstone was the place from which you would take all of your other measurements.
  - o And the place to which you aligned all other parts.

# C. Built, but not Finished (v.21)

• 1 Cor 3:9-11

#### D. Built for a Function (v.22)

- When God was in the Garden with Adam He was dwelling with man.
- God was working to dwell amongst His people to redeem them:
- Christ came John 1:14
- This is where we are today:
  - All the Citizens of Heaven (v19) are being BUILT together for a dwelling place of God's Spirit (V22)
  - o What God Is building in the CHURCH is a foretaste of Eternity:
    - Rev 21:3
    - Eternity is where our CITIZENSHIP/HOME CITY ULTIMATELY is, but the blessings of that and God's presence HERE, NOW
